- **2. Treasurer's Report.** Balance as of 9/18/2012 is \$674.03. One Disbursement paid in amount of \$145.37 on 8/8 for fringe benefits of city workers who did concrete work at the Water Tower. Members, please turn in any receipts for expenses before year-end.

She presented some ideas about future signage for the tower and the movie theater case which were designed by her business partner Tim Heffron. HPC graciously accepted Lemke's offer to donate the graphic work and photo for a sign for the movie theater case. Kessenich took the proof and will make some final tweaks. Commission will supply the foam core to mount the sign.

A. Water Tower

- 5. Damage to benches Doellstedt may attend the Welding Rodeo and speak with a local welder to see if they can offer any solutions about installing skateboarders stops.

- 6. Planting around mechanicals –Kessenich visited local nurseries comparing prices for trees to plant to block the sound from the large compressors.
